FIM AFRICAN COMMITTEE

CAMPAIGN FOR THE PRACTICES OF DECENT EMPLOYMENT OF MUSICIANS BY THE TOURISM INDUSTRY.

Motivation

Noting that the industry of " mass tourism " is more and more concentrated in the hands of large multinationals firms.

Noting also that, even in countries with very strong musical traditions, the tourism industrialists employ musicians without respecting the minimum standards of decent work, either relating to remuneration (when it is paid) or more generally to working conditions.

Motion

The Congress requests the Executive Committee to launch a campaign in favour of decent employment of musicians by the tourism industry. Such a campaign should be prepared on the basis of information received from the FIM members in the most concerned countries.
