Having regard to the needs expressed by Unions in Latin America and Caribbean regarding difficulties experienced in being received and heard by public authorities, regarding the fact that heads of companies are not aware of the musician's status as a worker and the lack of interest in other social sectors over training facilities, work and social welfare,

To promote a program to make social parties more conscious of the situation of musicians in Latin America and the Caribbean, with the support of ILO, so that governments and society in general be more aware of the situation of musicians in our countries and put forward solutions.
